Light Brown Apple Moth (LBAM) Quarantine

Brokers: Nursery Stock and Cut Flowers Shipping Requirements

Brokers / Distributors located OUTSIDE the State Interior Quarantine Area (located outside 1.5 miles of an LBAM detection) – known as the Federally Regulated Area

1. Sign a Compliance Agreement with exhibit “F” for the Federal Shield.
2. Only accept nursery stock/cut flowers from within the LBAM State Interior Quarantine Area or Federally Regulated Area if accompanied by proper certification (Certificate of Quarantine Compliance or Federal Shield).
3. Implement a BMP/IPM Program, only if receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
4. LBAM Program will conduct a 1 time inspection, only if receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
5. LBAM Program will place 1 trap per 5 acres with a minimum of 1 trap if less than 5 acres, only if receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
6. LBAM Program will service traps every 30 days, only if receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
7. Intrastate Shippers – A Certificate of Quarantine Compliance (CQC) must accompany each outgoing shipment of nursery stock originating from within the LBAM State Interior Quarantine Area.
8. Interstate Shippers – A Federal Shield must accompany each outgoing shipment of nursery stock originating from within the LBAM State Interior Quarantine Area or Federally Regulated Area, including nursery stock maintained on site.
