## Light Brown Apple Moth (LBAM) Quarantine

**Brokers: Nursery Stock and Cut Flowers Shipping Requirements** 

Brokers / Distributors located <u>OUTSIDE</u> the State Interior Quarantine Area (located outside 1.5 miles of an LBAM detection) – known as the Federally Regulated Area

- 1. Sign a Compliance Agreement with exhibit "F" for the Federal Shield.
- 2. Only accept nursery stock/cut flowers from within the LBAM State Interior Quarantine Area <u>or</u> Federally Regulated Area if accompanied by proper certification (Certificate of Quarantine Compliance or Federal Shield).
- 3. Implement a BMP/IPM Program, only if receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
- 4. LBAM Program will conduct a 1 time inspection, <u>only if</u> receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
- 5. LBAM Program will place 1 trap per 5 acres with a minimum of 1 trap if less than 5 acres, only if receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
- 6. LBAM Program will service traps every 30 days, <u>only if</u> receiving and maintaining nursery stock on site.
- 7. Intrastate Shippers A Certificate of Quarantine Compliance (CQC) must accompany each outgoing shipment of nursery stock originating from within the LBAM State Interior Quarantine Area.
- 8. Interstate Shippers A Federal Shield must accompany each outgoing shipment of nursery stock originating from within the LBAM State Interior Quarantine Area <u>or</u> Federally Regulated Area, including nursery stock maintained on site.
