Good morning,

As you may recall, on October 18, 2021, we recommended to the San Diego Sheriff's Department (SDSD) that CLERB staff with extensive death investigation experience respond to scenes of deaths arising out of or in connection with actions of deputies, to include in-custody deaths. Acting Sheriff Martinez has approved a process to facilitate CLERB's response to these scenes. This morning, Martinez and I signed a Memorandum of Understanding making CLERB's response to death scenes effective today. Afterwards, SDSD and CLERB issued the following press release: [Sheriff's New Critical Incident Policy | News Release | San Diego County Sheriff \(sdsheriff.gov\)](#)

This is a major accomplishment and will increase CLERB's independence. I am hopeful it also provides an increased level of trust in the investigatory process.

As of this moment, to ensure consistency and streamline our processes, I anticipate being the only CLERB staff member responding to these scenes for at least the next year. I will provide any updates as we work through this ground-breaking agreement.

I acknowledge the work and professionalism of Acting Sheriff Martinez, the SDSD Executive Team, and SDSD Division of Inspectional Services personnel in forging this agreement and their commitment to transparency and support of CLERB's independent role.

As you may recall, on several occasions over the past few months I advised CLERB that San Diegans for Justice (SDJ) commissioned a report into CLERB for the purpose of improving civilian oversight of the San Diego County Sheriff's Department (SDSD). I was interviewed during the course of SDJ's analysis and provided all publicly available documentation requested.

Earlier today, SDJ held a press conference in which it released its final report entitled, "San Diego County Citizens' Law Enforcement Review Board: Assessment of Strengths and Opportunities," which can be accessed at: [CLERB Report | San Diegans for Justice](#). I was interviewed by a few media outlets and agreed with the identified strengths and opportunities.
