After reviewing the CLERB Investigator's report and the Review Board's advisory Recommendation letter dated April 26, 2022, the Sheriff's Department understands the concerns expressed by the CLERB members and we will review the findings accordingly.

Your findings of deputies not completing safety checks properly in reference to SDSD DSB P&P I.64 – Safety Checks, not familiarizing themselves with SDSD Emergency Booking Acceptance Criteria, and a deputy failing to identify an anomaly on an x-ray during intake has been shared with the deputies' command staff for determination of appropriate administrative action, which may include additional training, and/or a referral for an Internal Affairs investigation.

It is our goal to provide the highest quality public safety services to everyone in San Diego County. We value work ethic and hold our employees to the highest of standards. We appreciate your service to the citizens of the County of San Diego.
