1. Use of Force Resulting in Great Bodily Injury – Deputies 1-5 used force toward Omar Rojas while he was incarcerated at the Vista Detention Facility.

22-092/AYALA

- 1. Illegal Search & Seizure Unidentified deputies impounded Ayala's vehicle.
- Misconduct/Procedure The SDSD failed to notify Ayala that his vehicle was impounded.
