SDPD In-Custody Death

On October 09, 2022, just after 10:00 p.m., Officers with the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) were dispatched to a family disturbance in the 3100 block of 39th Street in City Heights. When SDPD arrived, family members were restraining 23-year-old Denny Jalate on the ground outside of their residence. Officers placed Denny in handcuffs without incident. Shortly after being detained, Officers noticed Denny was in medical distress. Officers began life saving measures and called for paramedics. Denny was transported to a local area hospital for further treatment.

While at the hospital and despite hospital staff efforts, Denny's health declined and was pronounced deceased. No other family members were injured during this incident.

The Sheriff's Homicide Unit responded and has assumed responsibility of the investigation. The Medical Examiner was notified. An autopsy will be scheduled at a later date.
