The San Diego County Sheriff's Office welcomes and supports the Citizens' Law Enforcement Review Board's (CLERB) independent review of complaints alleging improper actions by members of the Sheriff's Office. The San Diego County Sheriff's Office continuously strives to respond with professionalism and concern to the citizens we serve, and the CLERB process provides invaluable input to that end.

CLERB sent the following policy change recommendation related to San Diego County Sheriff's Office Policy and Procedure:

1. It is recommended the San Diego Sheriff's Office (SDSO) update Detentions Services Bureau (DSB) Policy and Procedures Section L.2, titled Sanitation and Hygiene Inspections, to retain hard copies of weekly inspections for a period of two years as required by the County of San Diego Retention Policy Schedule.

Thank you for your recommendation regarding SDSO DSB P&P Section L.2. SDSO has updated Section L.2 to require two years retention of weekly hygiene inspection forms as specified in the current Sheriff's Retention Schedule (revised 2024).
