Types of work performed by GENERAL VOLUNTEERS in this category:

Certified Legal Interns work closely with Deputy District Attorneys in all phases of prosecution: appearing in court, drafting motions, conducting legal research, and assisting with major case preparation.

One Safe Place volunteer positions range from greeting and escorting guests/members within the center when needed, assisting guests/members seeking information and services, organizing donations, professional services such as haircuts, assisting with cooking classes and preparing food and snacks for guests/members, retrieving clothing donations from community members and taking donations to storage facilities, supporting donation drives, set-up for events and trainings, and transportation pick-up/drop-of services for members.

The DA Court Dog Program volunteers provide certified therapy dogs, in court settings, for child victims of physical, sexual, and emotional abuse. They also assist victims in preparing for court, testify and provide victim statements at sentencing hearings.

We work with various law schools – attending career fairs and events and conducting campus visits to meet with students and provide additional information about office and the internship programs we offer year-round. We also post internship opportunities on Symplicity, 12Twenty and other job posting platforms.

The One Safe Place Volunteer Program offers a unique opportunity for caring and dedicated individuals to help victims and survivors of abuse and trauma and their families. We offer unpaid internships for students and volunteers where they provide direct service to members, staff, and partners at our Center. 7. SPECIAL VOLUNTEER PROGRAM ACTIVITIES/ACHIEVEMENTS:

Please describe any special activities and/or achievements your program was involved in during the period of this report:

On July 15, 2022, our Summer interns participated in the 11th Annual George Bennett Closing Argument Tournament. This event gives the interns a chance to showcase their oral advocacy skills while receiving training and feedback from experienced trial attorneys. The interns are given a closed universe mock case file and are asked to craft an 8-minute closing argument based on what happened at the trial. The competition honors the legacy of George Bennett, the epitome of a "prosecutor's prosecutor," by focusing on improving argument and advocacy skills while stressing the importance of ethics and professionalism. 18 interns participated in the tournament and more than 22 DDAs volunteered as judges.

One Safe Place hosts community events every third Saturday of the month. Our volunteers assist with set-up, directing traffic, accompanying guests into the center, check-in and registration.
