## **Prevent Breeding**Dump Out Standing Water

Change water in

birdbaths often

Unclog rain

• Mosquitoes lay their eggs in standing water;

larvae can survive

### **Indoors**

- Change water weekly in pots, saucers, flower vases, and pet bowls
- Do not leave water out for longer than *1 week*

door and window

### Outdoors


- Dump out water that collects in toys, tires, storage containers, and buckets
- Cover trashcans and store wheelbarrows upright
- Circulate water in fountains and pools. If unused, add mosquitofish
- Drain water from plant pots and saucers. Flush out water in bromeliad plants

**Keep swimming** 

Store wheelbarrows upright Cover trashcans







- Unclog rain gutters and fix leaking faucets and sprinklers
- Put screens on rain barrel openings and prevent water from collecting on or around rain barrels





### Protect Yourself Fix holes in door and window

- Fix holes in door and window screens
- Wear longsleeved shirts, pants, socks and shoes when outside, even
  - during the daytime
  - Apply insect repellents such as DEET, picaridin, oil of lemon eucalyptus, or IR3535 to skin and/or clothing (always use as directed on the product label)



## **Stay Informed!** *Aedes* mosquitoes

- Have black with white stripes
- Will bite during the day
- Lay eggs indoors and outdoors
- Can spread diseases including Zika, dengue, chikungunya, yellow fever, and West Nile virus
- Lay their eggs in small amounts of water
- Eggs can become adults in as little as 1 week!


