• Regional Emergency Response

The County of San Diego issued a proclamation declaring a Local Emergency on Monday, January 23, 2024, and on January 24, 2024, the Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to continue this local emergency due to the on-going need for the communities. The County of San Diego has activated its Emergency Operations Center (EOC) at a level 1 with the storms. DEHQ Department Operations Center (DOC) was activated on January 24, 2024, and will be responding to flooding at auto body shops, food facilities and sewage issues. If you or someone you know was impacted by the storm, they can report damage in an online <u>survey</u> in English or a <u>survey</u> translated into more than 120 languages. DEHQ is also sending out this survey to all of our permitted businesses and community contacts to help the County get the word out.
