• Adopted a new budget for FY 2024/2025

The Board of Supervisors final deliberation on the FY2024-26 budget & change letter was held, June 25, 2024. The board unanimously voted to adopt the \$8.53 billion Chief Administrative Officer Revised Recommended Operational Plan, which includes a \$67.5 million budget for DEHQ.

Fiscal Year 2024/25 was unanimously approved by the Board of Supervisors on 6/26/24. This action supports the important work of the Vector Control Program and contributes to the health and wellbeing of the residents and visitors of the entire region.
