Hazardous Materials Spill/Release Reporting- In California, any significant release or threatened release of a hazardous material requires immediate reporting by the responsible person to the CalOES State Warning Center (800) 852-7550 and the Unified Program Agency (UPA) County of San Diego, DEHQ Hazardous Materials Division (858) 505- 6657. Federal Law - Notification to the National Response Center (NRC) 1-800-424-8802 is required for releases that is equal or exceed Federal Reporting Quantities (RQ) under EPCRA, and CERCLA.

**Paints-** PaintCare sites accept house paint and primers, stains, sealers, and clear coatings (e.g., shellac and varnish), but do not accept aerosols (spray cans), solvents, and products intended for industrial or non-architectural use. Paints must be in containers that are no larger than 5 gallons in size. Paint must be in its original container and the container must have a label and a secured lid. No open or leaking cans. **To get a California Temporary EPA ID Number-** Temporary ID numbers are issued to people or businesses who do not normally handle hazardous waste. These ID numbers are valid for 90 days.

**Trauma Scene Practitioners-** A trauma scene waste management practitioner is a person who undertakes as a commercial activity the removal of human blood, human body fluids, and other associated residues from the scene of a serious human injury, illness, or death. A practitioner shall register with the California Department of Public Health and shall follow Chapter 9.5, commencing with Section 118321, of the California Health and Safety Code, of the <a href="Medical Waste Management Act">Medical Waste Management Act</a>.
