





Need for Proposal

Discretionary Costs (18%):




Average Departmental Need: FY 2025-26 costs require 10.1% average fee increase.







LEA Solid Waste Program

• Emergency Illegal Disposal Regulations effective 2/14/25 and will become permanent. Regulates land application of compostable material.

WELL Program

 Updated Well Standards expected to be published by the CA Dept of Water Resources in Spring, 2026.

Next Steps

- Answer questions and hear all your feedback on our current programs.
- May 2025: Anticipated to present the Cost Recovery Proposal to the Board of Supervisors for their review.
- Approximately 2 weeks after the first reading: 2nd reading of Cost Recovery Proposal by the BOS.
- On July 1, 2025: New fees to go into effect.
