PUBLIC COMMUNICATION

There was no public communication.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes from the Monday, May 6, 2024, regular meeting were noted and approved without changes. Motion was made by Mr. Ken Kalbfell and Mr. Tom Wilson to approve without changes, passing with the ayes of all present.

AIRPORT DIRECTOR’S REPORT (Meadow Chase On Behalf Of Jamie Abbott)

In Mr. Jamie Abbott’s absence, Ms. Meadow Chase stated there were no updates available on the draft County of San Diego Airports Sustainability Management Plan (SMP), with it expected to become available to the FAAC and to the public upon completion. Ms. Chase also stated there were no updates available on the rehabilitation of Runway 18/36 at Fallbrook Airpark, a project remaining contingent on funding from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

AIRPORT MANAGER’S REPORT (Meadow Chase)

Under security items, Ms. Meadow Chase reported an incident on Tuesday, July 9, 2024, at Fallbrook Airpark involving a member of the airport management and operations staff and a member of the public from the Viewing Area. Ms. Chase stated there were no updates available on the potential extending of current contract security hours and the potential upgrading of the existing security camera system at Fallbrook Airpark. Ms. Chase also reported dumping, littering, sex in and out of vehicles, prostitution, underage drinking, drug use and potential drug deals, and public urination remained some of the recurring issues in the Viewing Area, noting the San Diego County Sheriff's Department's continuing involvement and patrols of Fallbrook Airpark in response. The FAAC expressed their support for the establishment of an official curfew for the public in the Viewing Area.

Requesting that it be included as an informational item on the agenda for the next regular meeting, the FAAC requested the County of San Diego Airports provide information on the possibility of an outside entity gifting a security camera system to the County of San Diego Airports for Fallbrook Airport or, alternatively, leasing space for a security camera system inside the Administration Office at Fallbrook Airpark for Fallbrook Airpark.

Under maintenance items, Ms. Chase reported the County of San Diego Department of Public Works surveyed Runway 18/36 at Fallbrook Airpark and were unable to detect any significant variations, or bumps, in the surface, in response to reports from select members of the FAAC.

Ms. Chase presented a historical graph depicting the monthly operations counts at Fallbrook Airpark for 2024 and four years prior. She reported the operations counts as 1,880 in May, 2024, 2,818 in June, 2024, and 3,544 in July, 2024.
