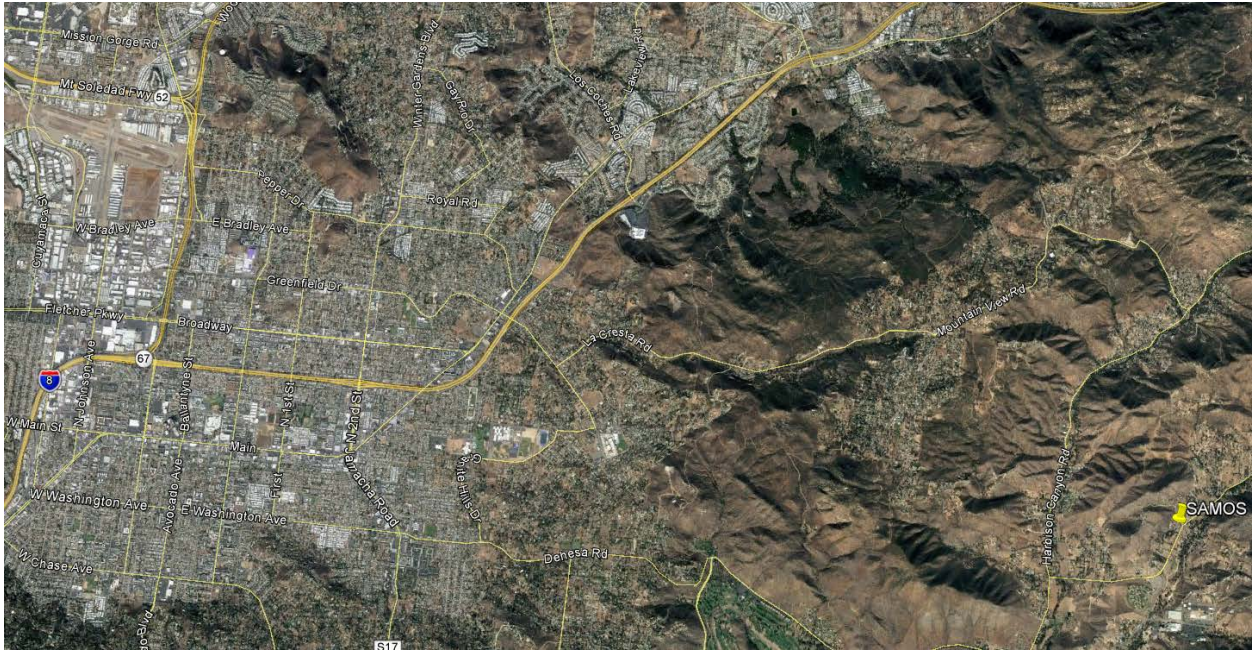

**SURPLUS PROPERTY DECLARATION
FORMER OUTER MARKER SITE (SAMOS)**



BACKGROUND

In 1974, San Diego County Airports acquired a 2,385-square foot property located approximately 8.5 miles east of Gillespie Field so the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) could install an outer marker beacon (SAMOS). The site, which is located in the front yard of the adjacent property, was originally acquired at a cost of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250).

In the early 1990's, the FAA determined this facility was not an effective navigational aid location since it is surrounded by higher terrain. The FAA decommissioned the site and granted the equipment to the County effective October 3, 1992.

County Airports' staff has determined this property is excess to airport needs and County intends to ask the Board of Supervisors to declare this property surplus land, so that it may be sold to the adjoining property owner, from whom it was originally acquired.

RECOMMENDED MOTION

“Gillespie Field Development Council recommends the Board of Supervisors declare Assessor's Parcel Number 510-090-38-00, the former Gillespie Field outer marker beacon site, surplus land pursuant to Government Code section 54220 and following, as recommended by staff.”
