Meeting Summary

1. QUORUM

The Chair determined that quorum was met and called the meeting to order.

2. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Jurisdiction representatives and guests introduced themselves.

3. REVIEW OF THE NOVEMBER 4, 2021 MEETING SUMMARY

Annika Andersen, City of Oceanside motioned to approve the November 4, 2021 Meeting Summary, Rimga Viskanta, City of Solana Beach seconded. Motion carried to approve the Meeting Summary.

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Mallika Sen, Solana Center for Environmental Innovation: The Solana Center completed a waste audit for Republic Services. The final report is being developed but noted the potential for food recovery at restaurants and that recyclables were not bagged. Solana Center continues implementing school lunch sorting programs in the unincorporated area. They also completed the last round of site visits to provide information on organics recycling requirements and provide technical assistance to 50 restaurants in the City of Carlsbad. Site visits in the City of Encinitas will begin shortly. The Smart Ways to Fight Food Waste Webinar is on December 2 at 6pm. Solana Center in partnership with RSWA cities and the San Diego Food System Alliance developed resource materials discussing SB 1383 and food donation. These resources are available here.

Geertje Grootenhuis, San Diego Food System Alliance: Geertje highlighted the SB 1383 Food Recovery Webinar which included 134 participants. The Alliance in collaboration with the County, Feeding San Diego and San Diego Food Bank developed the SB 1383 Handout. The Alliance also recently held a webinar and office hour session on the food capacity survey that was sent to hundreds of food recovery organizations and noted the concern of donation dumping.

Brooke Yaptangco Flinn, I Love a Clean San Diego: A list of <u>upcoming events</u> was shared including Storm Drain Stenciling Day in the City of San Diego (12/4), Celebrate Sustainably: Gifts and Glitz Webinar (12/8), and the Used Oil Filter Exchange Events at 5 event locations in the unincorporated areas (12/11). I Love a Clean San Diego continues to conduct site visits and work on recycling programs with schools in the unincorporated areas. Christmas tree recycling resources will be posted on WasteFreeSD soon.

Bob Hill, EDCO: Bob noted the impacts of port backups on processors.

Stephen Mergener, Zero Waste San Diego: Save the date for the next Zero Waste Symposium on February 8, 2022.

5. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: Eric thanked Laura Robinson for her years of participation and collaboration with the TAC as her last day with the City of Escondido is December 2. Eric also reminded the remaining jurisdictions to submit their Letters of Planning Document Accuracy for the CIWMP 5-Year Review Report.

6. CPSC UPDATE

Doug Kobold, California Produce Stewardship Council: CPSC will be sponsoring two bills in the new session to address batteries and 1-pound propane cylinders.

7. PRESENTATIONS

Cara Morgan, CalRecycle – Cara presented an overview of the difference between the SB 619 notification process and the enforcement process outlined in SB 1383 regulations. If jurisdictions decide to submit a notification under SB 619, it must be submitted by March 1, 2022. If you have any questions on the process, please contact your LAMD staff.

8. CALRECYCLE UPDATE

Haley Aumiler, CalRecycle, reported on the following:

- CalRecycle recently published SB 1383 information including <u>Resources for Non-Local</u> <u>Entities</u> and <u>Resources for Local Education Agencies: K-12 Public Schools and School</u> <u>Districts.</u>
- The SB 619 webinar recording is available <u>here</u>.
- CalRecycle LAMD staff continue to assist jurisdictions with SB 1383 planning. If you would like to schedule a call to review a potential Notice of Intent to Comply under SB 619, please let your LAMD staff representative know.
- Upcoming events include <u>Compost Use Best Management Practices Webinar</u> (1/19-20/22) and CalRecycle Public Meeting (12/21/21).
- SB 1383 Assistance Grants are tentatively scheduled to be released in January. This is a noncompetitive grant program that will provide local funding to jurisdictions to assist with SB 1383 implementation.

9. COVID-19 GENERAL DISCUSION – No discussion.

10. SB 1383 & AB 1826- ROLLOUT ROUNDTABLE

Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: The County continues to prepare for upcoming SB 1383 requirements including working with N&R Publications to develop an informational news insert for residents and businesses on SB 1383 and organics collection. Eric will share the resource with the group once finalized.

Laura Robinson, City of Escondido: Escondido's Organics Ordinance passed 12/1.

Annika Andersen, City of Oceanside: Annika asked the group for the status of jurisdictions' AB 1826 programs and compliance.

- Rimga Viskanta, City of Solana Beach: Solana Beach worked with EDCO to outreach to identified entities directly through letters and site visits. They also included AB 1826 requirements in the City's SB 1383 Ordinance.
- Laura Robinson, City of Escondido: Escondido also worked with EDCO for outreach.
- Eric Wolff, County of San Diego: The County reviewed service level reports and disseminated a survey to identified entities.
- Cara Morgan, CalRecycle: The CalRecycle Team is reviewing all San Diego jurisdictions that are on informal plans to determine if they need to move to formal plans. Additionally, Santee's letter to commercial businesses is a great example of notifying businesses of when they will need to have service.

Avecita Jones, City of Carlsbad: Avecita asked the group if any jurisdictions had mailed letters to school districts.

11. TARP YOUR LOAD/LITTER ABATEMENT – OPPORTUNITIES TO UNIFY OUTREACH

CalTrans is developing the <u>Clean California Local Grant Program</u> to support local communities and beautify and improve public spaces.

12. SUBCOMITTEES' REPORT

- **Household Hazardous Waste** City of Chula Vista staff will restart the HHW subcommittee meetings. Stay tuned.
- Organics The group continues to discuss compost and mulch best management practices
 and highlighted the upcoming CalRecycle webinar in January. The group also noted the
 concern of contamination for organics collection.
- **Edible Food Recovery** The group meets the second Monday of each month and recently discussed the edible food recovery survey. For more information, please contact Caitlin Lelles at Caitlin.Lelles@sdcounty.ca.gov.

Karen Clay, I Love to Glean: I Love to Glean works with around 20 food recovery organizations and noted that many are reaching capacity and are having to turn down food because there is no place to store it.
