2. Open Forum

- a. Mallika Sen, Solana Center: The Solana Center continues to conduct Tier 2 site visits and noted issues with organics sorting. Solana Center confirmed with CalRecycle that food recovery agencies can be enforced upon if they do not maintain recordkeeping requirements. - b. Valerie Lake, One Earth Recycling: Interest in a grant for neighborhood drop off programs to promote beverage container recycling. One Earth is looking to transition to a new location in Ocean Beach due to the sale of their current property site.

3. Regional education campaign

a. **Rick Anthony, Zero Waste San Diego:** Interest in creating a regional program to spread awareness on zero waste, recycling, and organic waste recycling principles. Stop Waste was noted as an agency that implemented something

4. Presentation: SB 54 Update – Heidi Sanborn & Timothy Burroughs, Alameda Stop Waste NSAC: In June 2022, Governor Newsom signed SB 54 into law to address the impacts of single-use packaging and food service ware. This landmark law will require a 25% source reduction by weight and unit by 2032 and require all single-use packaging and plastic food ware in California be recyclable or compostable by 2032. The law also includes a requirement for the plastic industry to pay a \$5 billion mitigation fund in efforts to cut plastic pollution and support disadvantaged, low-income, and rural communities impacted by plastic waste. 6. CPSC Legislative Update - Doug Kobold, California Product Stewardship Council:

- a. AB 2, Recycling: solar photovoltaic modules. 2 Year bill.
- b. SB 560, Solid waste: gas cylinders: stewardship program. 2 Year bill.
- c. **SB 707**, Responsible Textile Recovery Act of 2023. 2 Year bill.
- d. AB 246, Product safety: menstrual products: perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances. Vetoed by Governor.

- e. <u>AB 592</u>, Vehicles: commercial nonfranchise solid waste haulers: pilot program. Signed by Governor.
- f. AB 727, Product safety: cleaning products and floor sealers or floor finishes: perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances. Vetoed by Governor.
- g. <u>AB 1059</u>, Product safety: consumer products: textile fiberglass and covered flame retardant chemicals. Signed by Governor.
- h. AB 1238, Hazardous waste: solar panels. 2 Year bill.
- i. AB 1489, Solid waste: compostable covered materials. Vetoed by Governor.
- j. AB 1628, Microfiber filtration. Vetoed by Governor.
- k. SB 244, Right to Repair Act. Signed by Governor.
- I. SB 271, Powered wheelchairs: repair. Vetoed by Governor.
- m. <u>SB 303</u>, Solid waste: Plastic Pollution Prevention and Packaging Producer Responsibility Act. Vetoed by Governor.
- n. SB 353, Beverage containers: recycling. Signed by Governor.
