4. CalRecycle Update

a. The next monthly SB 1383 chat is scheduled for October 18 and will focus on edible food recovery implementation with school districts.

- b. CalRecycle Jurisdiction and Agency Compliance and Enforcement Branch continue to notify jurisdictions of the commencement of their compliance evaluations. Each jurisdiction will have a compliance evaluation at least once every four years.
- c. There is a new <u>CalRecycle Oversight and Enforcement webpage</u> available.
- d. I Recycle Smart campaign training resources for jurisdictions are available on CalReycle's <u>website.</u>
- e. An update on <u>grant/loan opportunities</u> was shared including SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant Program (application due 11/15), Community Composting for Green Spaces Grant Program (eligibility criteria and evaluation process posted on 9/13), Farm and Ranch Solid Waste Cleanup and Abatement Grant Program (application due 10/5/23, 1/9/24, 4/2/24), Tire-Derived Aggregate Grant Program (application due 12/6), Greenhouse Gas Reduction Loan Program (continuous), Recycling Market Development Zone Loan Program (continuous), Beverage Container Redemption Pilot Project Grant Program (continuous).
- f. Upcoming events include SB 54 Workshop (9/17), Statewide Illegal Dumping Technical Advisory Committee (11/1).

5. CPSC Legislative Update

- a. Nate Pelczar, California Product Stewardship Council: The last day for the Governor to sign bills is October 14. The Legislature reconvenes on January 3. A legislative update on the following bills was shared:
 - i. AB 2, Recycling: solar photovoltaic modules
 - ii. SB 560, Solid waste: gas cylinders: stewardship program
 - iii. SB 707, Responsible Textile Recovery Act of 2023
