#### 3. Presentations:

a. Colleen Foster, HF&H Consultants: SB 54, the Plastic Pollution and Packaging Producer Responsibility Act is the most comprehensive extended producer responsibility legislation in the nation for single-use packaging and foodware. This act aims to reduce the volume of plastic and packaging, increase recycling, shifts packaging pollution responsibility to producers, shifts costs from local jurisdictions/ratepayers, provides clarity and consistency for consumers, stimulates investment in reuse and refill systems, and fund cleanups efforts in disadvantaged communities. By 2032, 100% of single-use packaging and plastic single-use food ware much be recyclable or compostable, 65% of single-use plastic packaging and foodware must be recycled and there is a required 25% source reduction of single-use plastic packaging and foodware by weight and unit.
