ROUNDABOUTS IN REVIEW

OVERVIEW

Roundabouts are intersections that allow traffic to flow around a central island in a counterclockwise direction. They provide a safer alternative to signalized intersections and are increasing in popularity in the United States.

BENEFITS

O There is a 78% reduction in fatal and injury crashes compared to a signalized intersection.

- O Improves safety by reducing conflict points from 32 in signal-controlled intersections to 8 with a 4-legged roundabout.

- O Pedestrians only cross one direction of traffic at a shorter distance, allowing drivers to focus on pedestrians apart from entering/exiting. https://safety.fhwa.dot.gov/intersection/roundabouts/fhwasa15016.pdf
