STATE OF COMMUNITY PARAMEDICINE IN CALIFORNIA

- Authority
 - ► AB 1544 signed September 25, 2020
 - ▶ Bill went into effect on Jan 1, 2021, which became the purview of EMSA
 - Office of Administrative Law (OAL) approved regulations on October 31, 2022 following revisions
 - Regulations became effective on November 1, 2022
 - ► Toolkits distributed December 2022
 - Pilot program continues operation

- Updates
 - Members have been identified to fulfill key positions in the Community Paramedicine Steering Committee

 - ► Four policies will be reviewed by the Steering Committee at the first meeting.
 - ► Triage to Alternate Destination Paramedic Initial Accreditation, Reaccreditation, and Reinstatement
 - ► Community Paramedic Initial Accreditation, Reaccreditation, and Reinstatement
 - ► Community Paramedic and Triage to Alternate Destination Program Student Eligibility
 - ► Community Paramedic Training Program Requirements and Procedures for Approval/Reapproval
