- Surveillance
 - a. 2018-2019 Flu Season
 - 1. CDC data
 - a. 6.2 to 7.3 million people with flu
 - b. 69,300-83,500 hospitalized
 - 2. County of San Diego data published 01/09/19
 - a. 2083 cases, 11 deaths, 0 outbreaks
 - b. Predominantly influenza A and H1N1 sub-type
 - c. Encourage flu vaccination
 - 3. Health Flu order still in effect
 - 4. Jury Duty Letter No need to provide, will discontinue after 2019
 - Capacity Plan update Baseline level 5 increased to enhanced level 4 due to 2 recent triggers
 - a. Respiratory complaints
 - b. ED bypass
 - 6. Ebola outbreak update
 - a. Challenging to control due to high insecurity in the region
 - b. 600 confirmed cases and 343 deaths recorded second largest outbreak in history
 - c. Risk of spread globally remains low
 - d. The County is reviewing CDPH guidance from the State which recognizes Rady Children's Hospital as a receiving center for children and Cedars-Sinai Hospital for adults

 - b. Reminder the IV APAP protocol treatment for analgesia NOT fever
