II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made and seconded to approve the February 19, 2019 minutes. Motion carried.

III. COUNTY REPORT (Brian Christison)

- 1. Surveillance Met triggers for enhanced surveillance on capacity plan. Moved from baseline level 5 to enhanced level 4 (due to respiratory complaints and ED bypass)
- 2. Regular attendees at our routine County meetings may begin to receive calendar announcements from a new EMS Admin email account. This move by EMS will allow for greater control over the scheduling of our many EMS meetings. Upcoming Procurements:
 - 911 Advanced Life Support Ambulance Services for the National City Operating Area, San Marcos Operating Area, and the Unified Service Area (Inland North, Inland South, and Inland Central) in late spring 2019
 - Billing and Collection Services for patients transported from CSAs 17 and 69 ambulance districts.
- 3. Sidewalk CPR
 - Changing from a specific day to several days each year to reach largest number of target audience. County EMS will collect the annual total number of persons trained.

- 1. Submitted proposal for 1.5 million dollars funds requested. Grant to be awarded April 15, 2019.

V. SAN DIEGO HEALTHCARE DISASTER COUNCIL (Linda Rosenberg, RN)

- 1. May 7th Earthquake Drill
 - Focus on logistics 24-48 hours after
- 2. New Patient Tracking Tool created in Resource Bridge
 - Asking four hospitals to test Patient Tracking tool during the earthquake drill

VII. POLICIES & TREATMENT PROTOCOLS (Brian Christison)

Group discussion on formatting and content of protocols/policies: Decision to leave format as is and add new Public Safety Protocol.

- 1. S-127 Dysrhythmia
 - Adding Amiodarone changed from BHO to SO
- 2. S-166 Newborn (out of hospital births)
 - Approx. 60 a year
 - Goal: to help resolve difficulty in obtaining the birth certificate by adding Out of Hospital Birth Form (S166A), to provide to parent to help them obtain a birth certificate from Vital Records
 - Changes made to BLS: If HR remains, 60bpm after 90 seconds of ventilation, increase to BVM 100% O2; Complete "Out of Hospital Birth Form (S-166a) and provide to parent;
 - Added to 166a: Person who cut umbilical cord

3. S-413 MCI Protocol

Protocol held will review at April meeting

4. S-141 Pain Management

- Bring back protocol for further discussion at April's Meeting
- Changed mild-moderate pain score to 1-3
- Added "or" Refusal of Ketamine, Morphine, and Fentanyl, use Acetaminophen
- Change 0-3 to 1-3. 0 indicates no pain

5. Ketamine

- Group agreed on concentration of 50mg/ML
- Will further discuss the dosing at April's meeting
