# 6. OPIOID EPIDEMIC MITIGATION (Tyler Meick)

- Leave Behind Naloxone Program
  - Agencies who would like to participate to contact Nate Burger at Nathan.burger@sdcounty.ca.gov
- Prehospital Buprenorphine Program
  - Agencies may be eligible for grant funding to mitigate start-up costs associated with starting the program. If interested, please contact <u>Tyler.Meick@sdcounty.ca.gov</u> or <u>Nathan.burger@sdcounty.ca.gov</u>
  - Reminder as of July 1, 2024, Palomar and Sharp Grossmont assumed responsibilities of receiving base hospital contacts for prehospital buprenorphine patients instead of Highland Hospital. These facilities were chosen due to geographical locations to the participating agencies. Having to have only one base hospital contact will help the program.
  - Protocol S-145 update had several changes. Visit the County EMS website to view changes. Biggest changes included:

- Changing the age from 18 to 16, and
- Eliminating the need for an additional BH contact
