1. CALL TO ORDER AND OPENING REMARKS (Gary Vilke, MD)

• Dr Vilke called the meeting to order at 11:00 am.

2. OPENING REMARKS (Kristi Koenig, MD)

- Provided an update of the most recent information on the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Coronavirus cases continue to decrease nationally and across the state. Local wastewater monitoring indicates a decrease in the amount of virus present in the community.
- Our overall healthcare system remains incredibly busy.
- Discussed various strategies implemented to help mitigate system overload, including the revised Assess and Refer tool.
- Fentanyl fatalities remain a major concern. Fentanyl is now the #1 cause of death for Americans 18 to 45 years old. The "Leave behind Naloxone" program is helping to save lives.
- Indoor mask wearing is recommended. Vaccinations and boosters are encouraged when eligible.

3. COUNTY UPDATES (Jaime Pitner)

- A. The blood shortage in San Diego County continues. If possible, please consider donating blood.
- B. EMSA Waivers will come to a close on March 31, 2022.
- C. Local Optional Scope of Practice for EMT's/Paramedics to continue COVID-19/Influenza vaccination and testing has been approved to continue for three years.
- D. American College of Surgeons is currently conducting surveys of the six area Trauma Centers and concurrent County surveys are underway.
- E. Within the next few months an updated EMS fee schedule is expected to be presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval.
- F. County meetings will remain virtual.
- G. Capacity Plan has been lowered to Level 2, Escalated Activation. The Health Capacity Task Force continues to meet regularly to monitor the current situation.
- H. RFP for Evaluation of Base Station System and Trauma Catchment Areas designation is pending.
- I. RFP for Paramedic Ambulance Services for CSA 17 has been delayed, the current contract has been extended until July 1, 2022.
