FRAMEWORK FOR THE FUTURE

- July 1, 2021 Emergency Medical Services transitioned to San Diego County Fire
- Created an opportunity to bolster the EMS Office and better position it to be a regional leader
- County Fire developed the 2020-2025 strategic plan, already a catalyst for substantial improvements
- An opportunity exists to bring similar success to the EMS Office by developing and implementing a strategic plan for the next decade





FRAMEWORK FOR THE FUTURE

- Goal is to maximize collaboration and communication, so the EMS Office helps lead the region through critical public health challenges
- Regulatory oversight and functions as the LEMSA will continue, but the EMS Office will have a focus on data collection and planning, facilitation, preparation and forward-thinking initiatives
- The County EMS 2030 Strategic Plan, developed with input from public health and public safety partners, will serve as the foundation





FRAMEWORK FOR THE FUTURE

- Next step retain a consultant who will help guide the process of developing the strategic plan
- Consultant will work with County leadership and staff, and health and EMS stakeholders to gather necessary input
- County expects to have a consultant begin work in January and complete the process this spring
- The County EMS 2030 Strategic Plan will lay out the organizational mission, vision and values, and provide goals and measurable objectives
