Why is there an update?



NEMSIS (the National EMS Information System) has changed data standards – transitioning from Version 3.4 to Version 3.5



We are obligated by law to comply with state and federal EMS data standards



This means that the data collected on PCRs/incident forms in LEMSIS has been updated to meet the new standards



The major change in V3.5 revolves around the Disposition Field(s):

- Currently there is one field
 - ✓ Incident/Patient Disposition
- V3.5 has five fields that capture this data (separating out the information in the current field)
 - ✓ This Unit's Disposition
 - ✓ This Unit's Patient Evaluation/Care Disposition
 - ✓ This Unit's Crew Disposition
 - ✓ This Unit's Transport Disposition
 - ✓ Reason for Refusal/Release Disposition



Keep in mind the original general rule for creating PCRs is:

One PCR per Agency


- If transferring to a <u>different</u> agency use the transfer and KEEP option
- If transferring to your/the same agency use the transfer and remove option
- PCRs cannot be retrieved from the mobile devices if the wrong option is selected

- PCR rules/red flagging will help crews to enter the correct and logical sequence of these disposition fields




Treated and Transported by This Unit





First Responder Transfers Care to Another Agency/Unit to Transport – ALS or BLS






Against Medical Advice


An AMA or patient elope disposition can occur at any point of a call. AMAs can be recorded for specific transport or treatment reasons.

Example: Refusing transport to recommended catchment hospital because they will only go if they go to a favored hospital on the other side of town.






EMT Ambulance PCR when transporting a Care Modification from Paramedics*



^{*}previously referred to as BLS Downgrade




Assisting Primary EMS Crew






First Responder/Engine PCR:

Medic from Engine Transports/Rides in Another Other Unit/ Agency Ambulance and maintains patient care






Transporting Unit's PCR when a Member of Another Agency/Unit Rides In or Assists






Public Non-Patient Assist





- One of the new fields is Level of Care Provided to the Patient:
 - Located on the Home panel and the Narrative panel
 - This field records the <u>level of care that was provided to the patient</u>, not the credentialing/capability level of crew/unit







- During the week prior to Go-Live Crews must Post ALL incidents created on the current PCR form from all mobile devices
- Once the new form is on the mobile devices, incidents on the old form will not be visible.
 - This is why all runs need to be posted to Elite Web prior to the Go-Live date and time (2/6/2024 @ 0800)
- Crews can only see incidents on devices in which they are documented as a crew member, therefore
 there may be more incidents on a device than actually shown in the list (it just depends on who is
 logged in on the device)





- On the day of Go-Live Crews will need to the following at cutover time:
- 1. Finish current PCRs on devices
 - If out on a run and documenting an incident on the old form over the 0800 hour, finish the documentation, Post it, then sync the device
- 2. Post current PCRs to ensure they push to Elite Web
- 3. Sync devices to replace the existing PCR form with the new PCR form
 - From bottom left menu select Settings > Sync All Resources
