ENVENOMATION INJURIES

BLS ALS

• O₂ and/or ventilate PRN

• If antivenin available on site, transport with patient to hospital

Jellyfish sting

- Liberally rinse with seawater
- Scrape to remove stinger(s)
- Heat as tolerated (not to exceed 110 °F / 43 °C)

Stingray or sculpin injury

 Immersion in hot water (as hot as tolerated, not to exceed 110 °F / 43 °C)

Snakebite

- Mark proximal extent of swelling and/or tenderness
- Keep involved extremity at heart level and immobile
- Remove constrictive device(s)
- Remove jewelry distal to bite

- Treat per Pain Management Protocol (S-173)
