

PEDIATRIC TREATMENT PROTOCOL

S-172

BRUE (BRIEF, RESOLVED, UNEXPLAINED EVENT)

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BLS ALS

- Ensure patent airway
- O₂ saturation
- O₂ and/or ventilate PRN
- Monitor blood glucose

Suspected hypoglycemia or patient's blood sugar is <60 mg/dL (<45 mg/dL for neonates)

- If patient is awake and able to manage oral secretions, give oral glucose paste or 3 tablets (15 gm total)
- Patient may eat or drink, if able
- If patient is unconscious, NPO

BLS transport for currently asymptomatic patient with history of 1 or more of the following

- Absent, decreased, or irregular breathing
- Color change (cyanosis, pallor)
- Marked change in muscle tone (hypertonia or hypotonia)
- Altered level of responsiveness

- Monitor/EKG
- IV ^(A)

ALS transport for symptomatic patient
