Dr. Nicole Ayson is a physician board certified in both internal medicine and pediatrics. She received her residency training right here in San Diego at UCSD. From there, she joined the child abuse team at Rady Children's Hospital in 2016 where she continued to evaluate children due to concerns for abuse/neglect. In 2019, she joined the Palomar Forensic Health Services team as the medical director. In her role as medical director, she works with the sexual assault nurses, review cases, and provide medical guidance to the team.



Peter Estes is a Deputy District Attorney in the San Diego District Attorney's Office. He worked as an intern in 2012 and was hired on as a prosecutor in 2015. He is currently assigned to the Sex Crimes and Human Trafficking Unit, a position he has held since 2021. He has taken 37 cases to a jury trial.
