This would improve compliance with form submission. Also, please modify the first sentence under "Communication Information" to read, "What was your approximate location when you first attempted to make contact?" As multiple contact attempts are required, there will be multiple locations involved, but requiring an EMS provider to remember each specific location and report each one accurately will degrade form submission compliance. "

The EPCRs are already accessible to the county and comms failure can be tracked from there by adding or utilizing a few click options on the chart. Additionally, submitting electronically seems like vague instructions and burdens the crews with the additional task.
