TEMPORARY HOLDING FACILITIES

Temporary holding facilities are used to house detainees while arranging for their transportation to a booking facility, while continuing an investigation, or pending the detainee's release. All holding facility officers are knowledgeable of minimum jail standards, jail operation liability, gender and juvenile segregation requirements, emergency procedures and suicide prevention. Safety checks, intermittent direct visual and some audio supervision are routine. Phones are available for detainee's use in all facilities.
