Worried about folks Serving Seniors \$300 is a stopgap for a lot of folks; people use a lot of our services, those Covid funds were needed for nutrition and housing. • Molly – lobbying in March, Department of DDS, Legislative analyst’s freeze on rates. Trying to bring up to 2019 standards, not able to compete with min wages in private sector; hopeful that the lobby will be successful, one of the biggest dollar items. • Casey – Executive Director for UDW Resource Center, nonprofit that provides for public and private sector caregivers, partnering with UDW and California Community Colleges Chancellor’s Office, two colleges in San Diego, and will start with about 20 more coming up soon. Education wraparound services are included as well. Floods in San Diego: SD Foundation and UDW providing relief for caregivers, resource fair this Saturday 4/13/24. • RTFH – hosts a training on senior homelessness.
