Subject: Order of the State Public Health Officer | Unvaccinated Workers in High Risk Settings

On July 26, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released the Order of the State Public Health Officer Unvaccinated Workers in High Risk Settings. The order includes a requirement for facilities to verify COVID-19 vaccine status of all workers, respirator or mask requirements, and testing requirements. The Order applies to the following facilities:

A. Acute Health Care and Long-Term Care Settings:

- 1. General Acute Care Hospitals
- 2. Skilled Nursing Facilities (including Subacute Facilities)
- 3. Intermediate Care Facilities
- **B. High-Risk Congregate Settings:**
 - 4. Adult and Senior Care Facilities
 - 5. Homeless Shelters
 - 6. State and Local Correctional Facilities and Detention Centers
- C. Other Health Care Settings:
 - 7. Acute Psychiatric Hospitals
 - 8. Adult Day Health Care Centers
 - 9. Adult Day Programs Licensed by the California Department of Social Services
 - 10. Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) and PACE Centers
 - 11. Ambulatory Surgery Centers
 - 12. Chemical Dependency Recovery Hospitals
 - 13. Clinics & Doctor Offices (including behavioral health, surgical)
 - 14. Congregate Living Health Facilities
 - 15. Dental Offices
 - 16. Dialysis Centers
 - 17. Hospice Facilities
 - 18. Pediatric Day Health and Respite Care Facilities

19. Residential Substance Use Treatment and Mental Health Treatment Facilities
