This virus presents symptoms that resemble the flu:

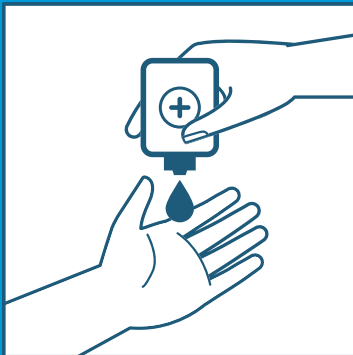
- Fever
