Whole person approach is crucial to success, focus on engagement, care coordination, evidence -based practices; provides treatment groups and pro-social activities Art expression through music, crafts, writing; staff and clients mesh interests, introduction to coping skills is crucial. Partners with other community-based organizations to help clients connect with service learning experience; parent/guardian involvement is key and PAG programs are included. Recovery can be fun!
