Criminal records can impact school applications, loans, professional licenses, etc. This program is free. Types of relief: sealing of adult arrest record, early termination of probation, reduction to misdemeanor, expungement (dismissal after the fact), DOJ correction, 290 registration relief, vacatur (completely wipes record), Prop 47 and Prop 64 reviews, and more!
