Gonzalo Opiate Treatment Programs (OTP) based out of harm reduction Can help those experiencing co-occurring disorder Patient / client can determine how long methadone treatment will last (Methadone Maintenance Model) Higher retention levels with OTP lead to higher success rates Highly regulated at fed, state and local levels Document hx of opioid use and dependency (prev. tx episode or other OTP tx) Soap Mat serves age 12+ <p>*need to de-stigmatize SUD population</p>
