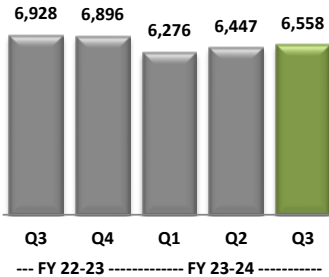

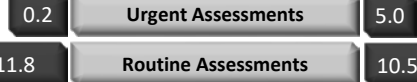

Mental Health Average Access Times† By Known Language Psychiatric



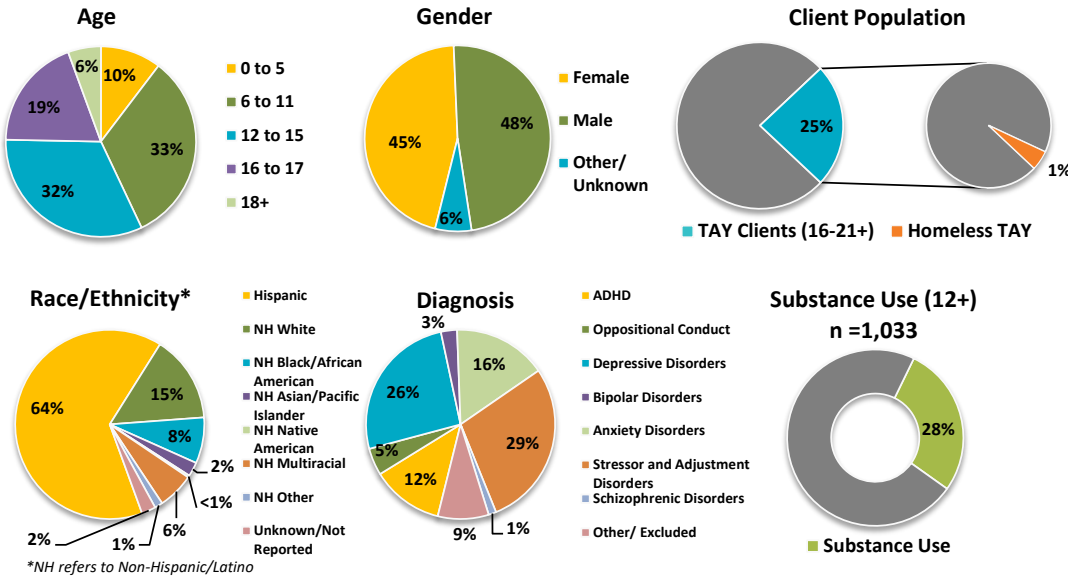
