Action Items • Healthcare Disparities Discussion Update (Piedad Garcia)	 HHSA applied for grant funding to address new Afghan arrivals, and it was obtained. ✓ Piedad facilitated a community engagement process made up of participants from East Africa and Afghanistan where we obtained 3 recommendations to provide Emotional Wellness and Self Care for children/youth and families and for Adult Afghan new arrivals. BHS will be amending existing contracts for this prevention and early intervention strategy. ✓ C are prevention strategies for the new Afghan arrivals. Community Engagement Report – Joint effort with UCSD: ✓ Liz Miles reported - The survey is still in discussion, under the new UCSD Outreach and Engagement contract. ✓ Currently doing MHSA Trainings and the Annual report was recently submitted. ✓ Dr. Garcia, Liz and CCRT representation to discuss what UCSD presented and discuss CCRT thoughts around recommendations to improve on the outcomes. ✓ Workgroup still have not begun, but Liz Miles to provide updates on the Community survey to keep track of status. Dr. Garcia will be participating at the latest Statewide ICCTM Learning Collaborative, which will include 11 trainings – 1st training on October 18th addressing cultural responsiveness.
