Chair's Report (Piedad Garcia)	 BHS had an External State Review for Drug Medi-Cal services BHS received approval from the Behavioral Advisory Board to proceed with the June Board Letter request for appropriations and authority to release request for proposal. In the Board Letter presented to the Behavioral Advisory Board, authority was requested to establish an East County Stabilization Unit. Current CSU's established: North Inland Palomar hospital based, Vista, and the most recent opening of the Oceanside Crisis Stabilization Units. The San Diego County Psychiatry Hospital has an EPU/CSU. In the south region there is t Paradise Valley Bayview. Currently proposing a County building in El Cajon to repurpose and redesign to create a CSU and sobering center. BHS is currently working with the City of San Diego in establishing a shelter on the campus of San Diego County Psych hospital. BHS will be providing the services. MCRT is doing well with the implementation of Law Enforcement referrals. Continue to go through ACL for referrals. Will be entering Phase 2 soon – school districts.
