C-HART (Community Harm Reduction Team) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A multi-disciplinary Behavioral Health Team, made up with licensed clinicians, substance used counselors, registered nurses, nurse practitioners, and psychiatrists. C-HART will be implemented in the City of San Diego, part of the harm reduction initiative with BHS To address primarily clients with substance use conditions that are hard to engage in services. Currently under discussions with specific providers on development and implementation of C-HART. BHS currently designing and developing a substance use transitional youth programs – Received Executive and HHSA approval. Currently procuring services for the clubhouses, as well as the Outpatient Mental Health Clinics. 	



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> BHS working with ARPA (American Rescue Plan) around sub cities, with the City of San Diego, San Diego Housing Commission, and Indio Unincorporated areas. San Diego has been allotted over three hundred sub cities, permanent supportive housing in the City of San Diego, and about other 200+ in the unincorporated areas.
