	<ul> <li>mHOMS workshop is coming up this Friday and CSS programs have another mHOMS training on Feb 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.</li> <li>Systemwide MHS Databook, Q1 FY 2017-18: The overall number of older adult clients receiving OABHS services in Q1 of FY 2017-18 decreased by 4.4% from the previous quarter. The OA clients utilized outpatient services the most in Q1, FY 2017-18 (5,534 visits among 1,400 clients). Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) was the second most utilized service by the OA clients (3,803 visits). The overall utilization stays relatively consistent quarter after quarter.</li> <li>November of 2017 had the highest 30-day readmission rate at fee-for-service (FFS) hospitals among older adults in FY 2017-18.</li> <li>The 30-day readmission rate to the San Diego County Psychiatric Hospital (SDCPH) among older adults in FY 2017-18 has been low, similar to the previous fiscal years.</li> </ul>
