4. Chair Report - Maureen Piwowarski, Chair	Request to move the meeting to 1.30-3.30pm. Need to confirm the meeting space availability.
5. Setting OAC Goals for 2017	<ul> <li>BHS 10 years Road Map and strategic framework were distributed.</li> <li>The OAC will discuss how many people will fall in the Older Adult category in the near future. Older adult population is growing - what to expect and how to plan.</li> <li>Can we explore other option to plan – using AIS maps showing where older adults are living?</li> <li>Review of the strategic plan for the aging population.</li> <li>20% of the funding is set aside for prevention and early intervention.</li> <li>There is a great need in the community to support aging population – older adults with dementia, Alzheimer, disabilities, SMI, homeless, adults needing custodial help etc. Special needs housing is a huge priority.</li> <li>Discussion ensued about forming a small work group to set goals, keeping in mind the current community needs and priorities. The work group will present to the OAC group the goals for further discussion.</li> </ul>
6. Nominating Committee for Chair Elect	The committee will meet after the OAC today to discuss potential candidates.
7. Behavioral Health Director's Report Update – Alfredo Aguirre	<ul> <li>The funding for Drug Medi-cal is unknown with the new administration.</li> <li>There would be impact on CA allocation. General Fund could be a potential funding for the gap in the Drug Medical.</li> <li>There is an upcoming meeting with Nick Macchione to decide to opt in or opt out. May 1<sup>st</sup> is the deadline for County decision.</li> </ul>

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	<ul> <li>No Place Like Home – there is a focus group working on the project. There is a \$2B bond to build units for homeless people with SMI. It's going to the Court in Sept-Oct 2017 for a decision to see if funds could be allocated with priority for this purpose or the County has to create another initiative.</li> <li>Supervisor D. Jacobs focuses on healthy aging communities and Alzheimer. She is working with private and County partners to put a pilot on crisis response and work with PERT.</li> </ul>
8. Older Adult SOC Update – Piedad Garcia	<ul> <li>There is focus group from UCLA working on community policy research and two focus groups will be held here in San Diego – Spanish speaking Latino population. The focus groups will most likely be held on March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017.</li> <li>POFA project is moving along with a joint RFP with San Diego Housing Commission. Currently the County is in negotiation with the contractor who will be servicing clients in East and South Region.</li> <li>No Place Like Home - \$135M from this initiative can create housing for homeless people.</li> <li>Innovation Cycle 4 – ROAM (Roaming Outpatient Access Mobile). New innovation project with 2 RVs servicing clients in the community from children, TAY, adults and older adults. The goal is 300 clients per mobile unit. The deadline for public comments on Cycle 4 proposals is May 2017 and for Cycle 3 proposals the deadline is March 23, 2017.</li> </ul>
9. MHSA update - Adrianne Yancey	<ul> <li>There are 6 focus groups working with the community forums on 15 themes. A one pager was distributed to show the top 3 essential themes by region. 500 participants also created a Graphic expression of what are communities are.</li> <li>Mental Health Services Act is located on the web site sandiego.camhsa.org.</li> <li>Innovation projects are in 30 days public commentary period. There are 5 proposals for extension and/ or expansion in Innovations Cycle 3. There are 5 new innovation project proposals in Cycle 4 and some are out for bidding.</li> </ul>
10. QI Update – Dasha Dahdouh	<ul> <li>Krystle Unanzor on behalf of Dasha Dahdouh presented a data base report YTD for Older Adult Mental Health Services. Report is attached.</li> <li>Databook is available on TRL website.</li> </ul>
