BHAB 2024 Priorities

Each year, the Behavioral Health Advisory Board (BHAB) identifies behavioral health priorities that enhance BHAB's value to the community and may inform the establishment of BHAB subcommittees. The priorities listed below, as identified by BHAB members through member discussion at BHAB convenings, focus on behavioral health policy implications while acknowledging the intersection with criminal justice and community engagement.

Behavioral Health Policy Implications

- California Proposition 1
 - Maintain awareness and advise on County of San Diego Behavioral Health Services (BHS) programs and services impacted by the implementation of Proposition 1.
- Senate Bill (SB) 43
 - Advise and maintain awareness of SB 43 implementation planning in San Diego County.
 - Advise on SB 43 community engagement efforts to build awareness and knowledge among key audiences.
 - Advise on SB 43 peace officer and clinician trainings.

It is THEREFORE, recommended that BHAB vote to approve the BHAB 2024 priorities.
