Overview





Senate Bill (SB) 43

- Broadens the definition of "gravely disabled", expanding involuntary treatment protocols to include:
 - Severe substance use disorder, or a co-occurring mental health disorder and a severe substance use disorder
 - Inability to provide for medical care or personal safety

Board of Supervisors (Board) Action – December 5, 2023 (6)

- Establish a multi-sectoral implementation planning process
- Add support for additional funding for SB 43 to the County of San Diego 2024 State Budget Advocacy
- Return to the Board in 90 days with an update on the implementation planning process






