# ADOLESCENT PROGRAMS

The County of San Diego provides developmentally appropriate substance use disorder (SUD) treatment (including Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)), early intervention, peer support, and recovery services using a harm reduction approach to help youth reach their full potential. These programs serve adolescents and their families, ensure access to care, and promote selfsufficiency through education and/or employment and engagement in prosocial activities. Services are offered throughout the county in urban and rural communities and include school-based early intervention screening and education, outpatient treatment, crisis intervention, and residential treatment services.

# **Access to Services**

Services shall not be refused to clients based on race/ ethnicity, disability, culture, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or the inability to pay, if the client meets the County's eligibility population requirements. Clients who are CalWORKs eligible shall not be charged fees. Clients who are DMC eligible shall not be charged fees unless there is Share of Cost (SOC).
