

What is SchooLink?

SchooLink is a partnership between the County of San Diego and local school districts to provide behavioral health services at schools. This SchooLink training program provides an overview of SchooLink, template forms, best practices for linking students to behavioral healthcare services, and additional resources.

There are many campus and community-based behavioral health resources, but many students, parents and school personnel don't know they exist or how to access them.
