- Customize the **SchoolLink brochure** for your school(s).
- Place **SchoolLink posters and brochures** in key locations where staff and families gather.
- Check and replenish **SchoolLink posters and brochures** periodically.

Did you know there is a new California law (AB2022), effective January 1, 2019, that requires the education system to inform pupils and parents/guardians on how to initiate access to available pupil mental health services on campus or in the community? SchoolLink and school staff may use the SchoolLink posters and brochures to fulfill this requirement and increase awareness about SchoolLink services.

The SchoolLink **poster** details the pathways to youth behavioral services in San Diego County. The SchoolLink **brochure** provides standardized, simple language on services and eligibility and is customizable for each school and SchoolLink provider.
