Placements (Age 0-17) - First of each month - Monthly Average of Fiscal Year to Date (July 2024 - Nov 2024)




Placements - Five counties with the highest child population comparison (On October 01, 2024)





















Extended Foster Care (Age 18-20) - Monthly Averages of Fiscal Year to Date (July 2024 - November 2024)


